

# How to apply for partnership funding

**We would like to hear from your organisation if you have a project that is:**

- Large scale, innovative and of State-wide significance
- Suited to funding from more than one partner
- Outcome focused and suited to performance measures
- Able to promote skills development and build community capacity
- Able to work in partnership with Rio Tinto and its WA businesses

**We are unlikely to fund:**

- Projects that primarily focus on capital works
- Private companies seeking finance for their own business activities
- Individuals wanting to finance endeavours solely for personal gain
- Mainstream government services
- Activities and events that have already occurred
- One-off events such as conferences or seminars

**To apply for funding you need to write a 2-3 page application addressing the following:**

## PROJECT DETAILS

- A summary of the project, including a timeline
- Expected outcomes of the project
- Who will benefit from the project
- How the project will be managed

## SUSTAINABILITY

- How was the need for the project identified, including any community consultation, studies or previous projects
- How does the project provide long term solutions not already available in WA
- In what way is the project sustainable beyond the support of Rio Tinto

## FUNDING

- Total project budget
- Funds sought from Rio Tinto
- Other sources of funding sought, eg government
- The value of any in-kind support

## EVALUATION AND REPORTING

- Outline how you will measure the outcomes of your project
- How will you communicate your project to the wider community
- In what way will the project be a partnership with Rio Tinto
