

How to apply for sponsorship to Rio Tinto in Western Australia

Rio Tinto supports sponsorships that have a clear community benefit for WA and enhance the reputation of our business. Sponsorships may include financial and/or in-kind support.

We would like to receive your proposal if you have a project that will:

- Benefit communities that neighbour Rio Tinto operations in WA
- Enhance Rio Tinto's reputation amongst relevant stakeholders and communities
- Be consistent with our corporate identity and values
- Relate to Rio Tinto's core business
- Demonstrate value for money
- Provide a benefit to Rio Tinto employees
- Be a not-for-profit project

Sponsorships will not usually be allocated for:

- Private companies seeking finance for their own business activities
- Proposals solely for capital works
- Projects benefiting an individual
- Proposals traditionally funded by government
- Political activities
- Conferences seminars or travel

To apply for a sponsorship valued at over \$5,000 you will need to submit a 1-2 page proposal addressing the following:

- A clear and concise description of the event/project
- Details of the request
- A clear communications plan
- Proposed budget/funding
- Sponsorship benefits to Rio Tinto
- Sponsorship benefits to organisation
- How the project will be managed/implemented
- Specified measurable outcomes
- A monitoring and evaluation plan
- Details of target audience

Application process:

- Establish the correct point of contact from list on reverse and send us your proposal (if unsure, complete an Enquiry Form on www.ciwa.riotinto.com).
- For sponsorships valued below \$5,000, telephone the appropriate contact for more information.
- Applications will be assessed according to the availability of funds and the ability of the project to meet the criteria above.
- We will review your proposal within one month of receiving it.
